Our Awe-Inspiring God – Psalm 29

In this psalm, a violent storm leaves David standing in awe of the power and majesty of God. Only when we are overwhelmed with God can we respond to Him appropriately, as God's people do in this text. When we are awe-struck by the Person and Work of God, we are led...

1. To worship God (1-2).

These verses highlight two important aspects of worship:

- a. We must *ascribe worth* to the Lord an action of the mind.
- b. We must *bow down* before the Lord an action of the will.
- 2. To praise God (9). "Glory" = kabod

- 3. To trust God (10-11).
 - a. He is the sovereign ruler over all the earth.
 - b. He is the source of blessing for God's people.
