The gospel of Christ is the *good news* that Jesus died for our sins and that He rose again. In order for a lost sinner to receive salvation, he or she must believe *both* of these truths. But what is the relationship between Jesus' death and His resurrection? What do they have to do with one another?

Last Lord's Day...

1. They are connected by *chronology*: the crucifixion preceded the resurrection.
Matthew 16:21
2. They are connected by *principle*: death must come before life.
John 12:20-33

Today...

3. They are connected by *remuneration*: the crucifixion was the price of the resurrection. Hebrews 13:20-21
4. They are connected by *vindication*: the crucifixion was validated by the resurrection. 1 Corinthians 15:12-20
