The Supremacy of Christ: Redemption (part 1) – Col 1:18

Colossians 1:15-20 appears to be a first-century hymn with two parallel stanzas exalting Christ as supreme over all. In the first stanza, Christ is exalted for His work of creation; in the second, His work of *re*-creation, or redemption. To begin our worship of Christ as we meditate on this second stanza, we must answer the question, *what language does Paul employ in order to exalt the Lord as supreme?*

1. A supreme position: *Headship And He is the head of the body, the church...*

- 2. A supreme foundation:
 - A. Beginning
 - B. Firstborn from the dead
- 3. A supreme goal: *Preeminence* ...that in all things He may have the preeminence.
