

The “Mystery” in Colossians—Colossians 1:24-2:3

Paul explains that the Lord had commissioned him a minister of the “mystery.” This is an important term that amplifies our understanding of the letter to Colossae as well as the significance of the Lord’s Table. What does Paul mean by “mystery”?

1. “Mystery” is the message of God revealed.
Which has been hidden...but now has been revealed

2. “Mystery” is the message of unity in Christ.
That we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus

3. “Mystery” is the message of “Christ in you.”
Christ in you, the hope of glory
 - a. This message is the ground of the believer’s union.

 - b. This message is the ground of the believer’s hope.
