Pressing on to Perfection, Part 3 – Heb. 5:11-6:20 Greg Stiekes, Pastor

Again the author of Hebrews diverges from his main topic in order to exhort his readers. As Jesus was "perfected" because He "learned obedience" (5:7-10), so must we also hear and obey if we would "go on to perfection" (6:1). Disobedience breeds spiritual immaturity and immaturity breeds apostasy; but our perfection rests in the promise of God through Christ, our High Priest.

	n. Maturity is measured by knowledge (5:11-13; 6:1-2)	
	o. Maturity is measured by discernment (5:14). Discernment, which is an ability to make appropriate judgments, is marked by four characteristics:	
	(1) It is habitual: by reason of use.	
	(2) It functions in the moral faculties: <i>senses</i> .	
	(3) It is the product of training: <i>exercised</i> .	
	(4) It mandates a value judgment: good and evil

3.	Perfection is based upon the promise of God (6:9-20).
