Principle # 3 – Revival starts with God's people indicating NEW LIFE, implying that there is already life that exists.

Principle # 4 – Revival does not need to be spectacular.

Principle # 5 – Revival puts God back on the throne and causes His people to reverence His name, His person, and His Word.

Principle # 6 – Revival is God's response to the obedience of His people. He sovereignly works with those who obey His Word (John 14:21).
