

FORGETTING TO BE THANKFUL—PSALM 103:1–13

We will celebrate Thanksgiving in America this coming Thursday, but how many people will truly remember to be thankful to God. Turkey, family and Black Friday will cause many to forget what Thanksgiving is all about. Yet thankful-ness is the pulse of the Christian life—a sign of spiritual health. Psalm 103 is totally an expression of praise and thankfulness moving from personal praise (1–5) to grace and mercy abounding and closing with a doxology of praise (19–22).
