# The Efficacy of the New Covenant, Part 2 from Hebrews 8:7-13 Greg Stiekes, Pastor

God established a covenant with His people, Israel, by which He invited them into fellowship with Him. Never-theless, Israel could not keep their end of the covenant. If there was going to be perfect harmony with God, God Himself would have to reconcile His people uncondition-ally. So God, through His Son, provided a New Covenant. This New Covenant is efficacious because it secures *several eternal blessings* that God Himself puts into effect for those to whom the covenant is extended:

1. It secures the *obedience* of God's people.

I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts (v. 10a)

2. It secures a *relationship* between God and His people. *I will be their God, and they shall be My people (vv. 10b-11).* 

3. It secures the forgiveness of God's people.

I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more (v. 12).
