A Virgin Bears a Son – Matthew 1:18-25 Pastor Greg Stiekes

When Joseph is devastated by the news that Mary, his wife-tobe, is expecting a child, God reveals to him that all is yet well. For God Himself is moving in a miraculous and unprecedented way to accomplish His promises. In this text there are three reasons Mary's conception, though troubling to Joseph, reveals the power and salvation of God:

1. Mary's conception is the work of the Holy Spirit:	
That which is conceived in her is ek pneumatos hagiou	(20)

2. Mary's conception is the means of God's salvation: *And she will bring forth a Son* . . . (21).

3. Mary's conception is the fulfillment of God's Word: *So all this was done that it might be fulfilled . . .* (22-23).
