Keys to Future Success *from* Joshua 5:13-6:2 Pastor George Stiekes

So where do we go from here? We liked things the way they were before! The seven dying words of the church are well known – We've never done it that way before! The children of Israel were up against a new endeavor. Jericho was before them and God is about to give Joshua some very unusual directions. When God calls His people to do something new, He also gives them the instructions on how to do it! Sometimes His plans may seem foolish and yet His way is perfect (II Samuel 22:31). For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my way, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts (Isaiah 55:8-9). It all boils down to this: Is it really about God or is it about me?

Outline

Success is achieved when we accomplish what it is God created us and saved us to do, regardless of the changes God might make in our lives or in our church. In Joshua 5:13 – 6:2, Joshua discovered seven principles for success. Success is natural when:

- 1. You give attention to the Word of God (Joshua 1:8).
- 2. You discover that you are not alone (5:13-14).
- 3. You discover that service follows genuine worship (5:14).
- 4. You come face to face with God (5:14).
- 5. You recognize that you are second in command (14).
- 6. You discover you are on holy ground (15).
- 7. You recognize that you are already the victor (6:1-2).
