#### The Future Restoration of God's People Today from Ephesians 1-2 Pastor Greg Stiekes

As believers in Christ we long for the future promise that what was shattered in the Fall will be perfectly restored in the Eternal State. But Paul tells us that this promise is being fulfilled already! Because of the
