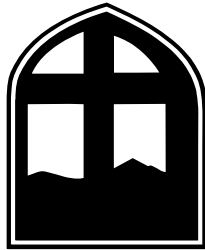

The Healing of the Paralytic *from* Mark 2:1-12

Pastor George Stiekes
