# The Stunningly Supernatural Scriptures *from* 2 Peter 1:20-21 Ryan Martin, Associate Pastor

In vv 12-15, Peter is urging the Christians to continue believing his teaching, especially his teaching about the second coming of Christ. Peter reminds the church in vv 16-18 that the teaching about the second coming of Christ was not made up out of the blue. No, on the contrary, they were eyewitnesses to the second coming majesty of Christ at the Transfiguration. In v 19 Peter says that the Transfiguration confirms Old Testament prophecies about Christ.

The point is that we must with the eyes of faith focus our spiritual attention on the Scriptures. Peter suggests three reasons why:

1. The Scriptures are not a collection of human interpretations.

2. The Scriptures were not produced by the will of man.

3. The Scriptures were produced by the Holy Spirit of God.
