

# Weekly Catechism

#### 80. Q. What is Baptism?

A. Baptism is an ordinance of the New Testament, instituted by Jesus Christ<sup>1</sup> to be a sign of the believer's fellowship with him, in his death, and burial, and resurrection,<sup>2</sup> of his union with him,<sup>3</sup> of remission of sins,<sup>4</sup> and of his giving up himself to God through Jesus Christ, to live and walk in newness of life.<sup>5</sup>
