GOD'S TIMING IS ALWAYS BEST from 2 PETER 3:8-10 Ryan Martin, Associate Pastor

In verses 8-10, Peter assures the believers that the day of the Lord will come. The false teachers were questioning if the Lord was coming back. Peter insists, yes, he will return. Salvation and judgment is coming. But if the day of the Lord is coming, why the delay? What's taking so long?

Peter writes these words to urge us to continue to look for the Lord's return. God's Word for us this morning is that we as believers must continue to hope in God's promise of salvation. We must believe that God's timing with the day of the Lord is best. Peter gives us three reasons to remain hopeful in the promised return of Jesus Christ:

1. Our God is above Human Time.

2. Our God Keeps His Promises.

3. Our God is Longsuffering.
