# THANKFULNESS WORTHY OF GOD—PSALM 116 Pastor Greg Stiekes

You may have once said, "Words cannot express my appreciation." Or, "This gift is only a token of my thankfulness." Sometimes what we are able to say or give cannot possibly match the sheer gratitude we feel. This is the author's dilemma in Psalm 116: "What shall I render to the Lord for all his benefits to me?" 1. A heart of *sincerity*.
