## JESUS' MISSION PROGRAM (CONTINUED) — LUKE 4:16–21 Greg Stiekes

In the synagogue of his hometown of Nazareth, Jesus launches his public ministry by declaring his *mission*: to rescue *hopelessly defeated outsiders* by offering them genuine release from their situation—for the ultimate *Jubilee* has come! Jesus was sent by the Father and anointed by the Holy Spirit to fulfill the mission detailed in Isaiah 61:1–2a, seeking to save four specific kinds of desperate people:

#### Previously:

- 1. Those who are **bankrupt spiritually** *to proclaim good news to the poor*
- 2. Those who are **bound morally** *to proclaim liberty to the captives* 
  - a. Sin binds us with its penalty.
  - b. Sin binds us with its power.
- 3. Those who are **blind intellectually** [to proclaim] recovering of sight to the blind

4. Those who are **broken emotionally** *to set at liberty those who are oppressed*
