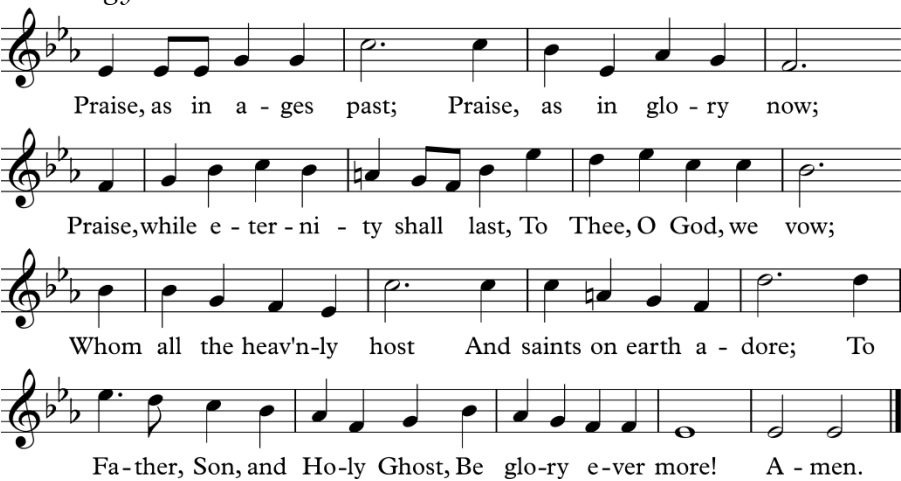

for the LORD our God is holy!

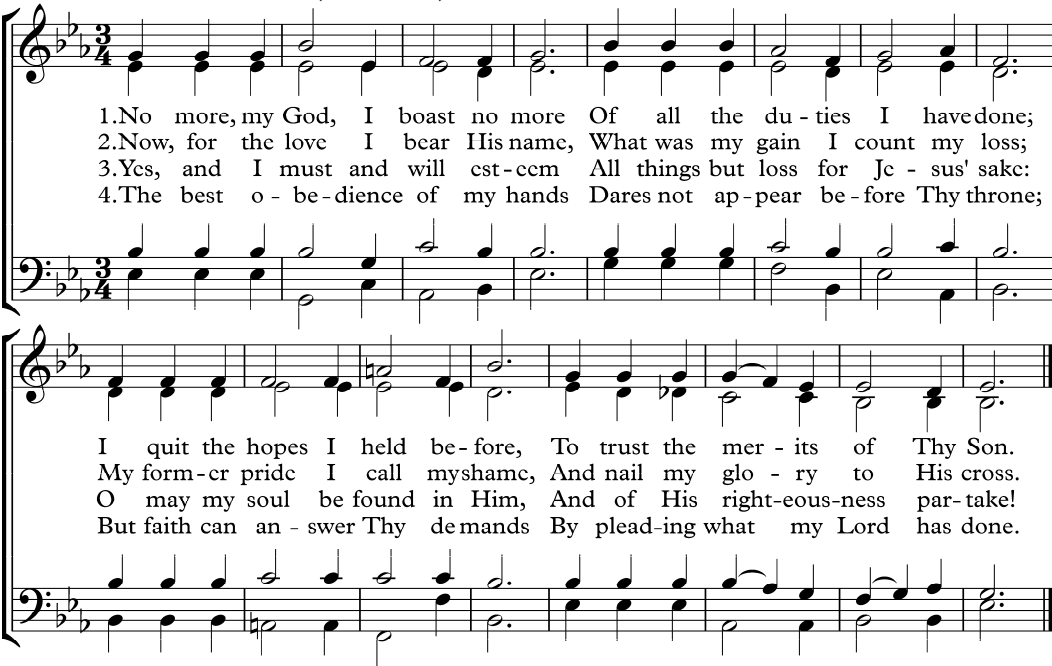
