KIDS4TRUTH Q&A AND MEMORY VERSE FOR NEXT WEEK

Q. What was the main way God made known His grace and glory during New Testament times and up until now?

A. 1Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. (1106)

And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption (Ephesians 4:30). That was Paul's instruction to the saints in Ephesus. Such instruction would not be given to those who are unsaved because they are not indwelt by the Holy Spirit. This is one of the major differences between believers and unbelievers. There are times in the believer's life when the presence of God's Spirit is not recognized and we need to be reminded of His presence. What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own (1Cor. 6:19). Failing to daily walk in the Spirit can lead to serious trouble as illustrated in the lives of Ananias and Sapphira who ended up grieving the Holy Spirit.
