The God Who Remembers – Exodus 2, 6, 32 Greg Stiekes, Pastor

When it comes to the covenants God establishes with His people, the word "remember" is full of special significance. God's "remembering" His covenant does not mean He suddenly recalls it to mind; it means that He honors the covenant or pays attention to it. God's willingness to "remember" His covenant highlights three splendid aspects of God's character:

1. God is truthful (Exodus 6:2-8): *He intends to do exactly as He promises.*

2. God is faithful (Exodus 2:23-25): *He keeps His promises*.

3. God is merciful (Exodus 32:1-14): He keeps His promises, in spite of human failure.
