Our Identification in Christ – Colossians 1:3-9; 4:12-13 Greg Stiekes, Pastor

What does a life lived "in Christ" look like? Does it have any practical value? The man Epaphras, whom Paul commends to the Colossian church, is a wonderful example of what it means to "walk in Him" (2:6). As Epaphras demonstrates, walking in Christ means that the believer finds his *identity in Christ* in three practical ways:

1.	He identifies with the <i>servants</i> of God.
2.	He identifies with the <i>church</i> of God.
3.	He identifies with the <i>Son</i> of God.
