

Worthy of Christ, Part 2 – Colossians 1:9-14

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As we saw in our last study, to walk *worthy* of Christ means to walk in a way that is consistent with the person we are in Him. But how do we learn to walk worthy of Christ? And how do we know when we are walking worthy? These are the questions we now turn to as we continue to examine this great prayer of the apostle Paul.

1. How do I walk worthy of the Lord? (1:9)

- a. I must be filled with the knowledge of His will.
- b. This knowledge comes through *all spiritual wisdom and understanding*.

2. How do I know if I am walking worthy of the Lord?

Paul highlights four specific qualities that will be true of a believer who is walking worthy of the Lord:

- a. Fruitful good works (1:10)
- b. Knowledge of God (1:10)
- c. Strong endurance (1:11)
- d. Joyful thanksgiving (1:12)
