Trials in the Midst of Rejoicing (Part 2) Greg Stiekes, Pastor

We have seen that in Philippians 2:14-18, Paul urges the church not to 'grumble' but rather to 'rejoice.' In 4:6-7, however, Paul tells them how rejoicing believers respond when trials come. As we unpack this familiar text, we note that Paul gives instruction followed by a promise:

1. The Instruction for Those Who Rejoice This instruction has two necessary parts:	
a. Worry about nothing.	
b. Tell God about everything.	
2. The Promise for Those Who Rejoice "Peace" will "guard your hearts and minds."	
a. The source of this peace: "of God"	
b. The quality of this peace: "surpasses all understanding"	
c. The Mediator of this peace: "through Christ Jesus"
