Heavenly Citizens and Their Difficulties – Philippians 4:4-7 Ryan Martin

Paul makes clear in 4:1 that because of our heavenly citizenship we should stand in the Lord. Not only does this statement look back to the text preceding but forward as well. That is, so stand anticipates vv. 2-9 where Paul gives concrete ways of standing fast in the Lord. In vv. 2-3 Paul admonishes the Philippians with respect to their unity in the Lord. Verses 8-9 address the believer's mind and the importance of following Paul's example. Our focus this morning will be on vv. 4-7, where Paul addresses our inner life in the midst of difficulties. Stemming from the heavenly citizenship (3:20), our passage offers three ways Christians stand fast in the faith amidst life's difficulties:

1.	Heavenly citizens rejoice in the Lord always (v. 4).
2.	Heavenly citizens are gentle with all (v. 5).
3.	Heavenly citizens pray in everything (vv. 6-7).
