The Lord's Table is a wonderful reminder of God's love for His own. In this life we will never know or understand the depth of His love toward us. Romans 5:8 reminds us, *while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us*. Without that rescuing love, we would all be helpless and hopeless, as a result of our sinful condition *for there is none righteous, no not one* (Rom 3:10).

The Early Christians celebrated the Lord's Table in connection with a love feast. They were to *tarry for another* (I Cor 11:33), showing proper concern for one another and love. The Apostle Paul desired that believers would have the same love one for another resulting in a unity unknown by those outside of Christ (Phil 2:1-5). This kind of love and unity can only be displayed by those who have truly experienced the love of God. Let us note together nine characteristics of God's Wonderful Love.

- 6. God's Love is Permanent in Duration (Rom 8:38-39)
- 7. God's Love is Personal in Intimacy (Jn 14:21; Gal 2:20)
- 8. God's Love is Supportive in Strength (Gal 5:6)
- 9. God's Love is Evidential in Proof (Rom 5:8)
