- 1.1. *Definition*: The Holy Spirit was involved with the work of creation.
- 1.2. Genesis 1:2
- 1.3. **Ps 33:6** By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their host.
- 1.4. Job 26:13 By his wind the heavens were made fair; his hand pierced the fleeing serpent.
- 1.5. **Ps 104:29-30** When you hide your face, they are dismayed; when you take away their breath, they die and return to their dust. [30] When you send forth your Spirit, they are created, and you renew the face of the ground.

 - 4.4.5.1. Not particular moral in character,
 - 4.4.5.2. Often resulted in great physical ability, and
 - 4.4.5.3. Was connected with the regal functions the judges had as mediatorial rulers in Israel's government.
- 4.5. Likewise, 1 Samuel tells us of the Spirit coming upon and eventually leaving King Saul.
 - 4.5.1.1 Sam 11:5; 1 Sam 10:6; 10
 - 4.5.2. 1 Samuel 16:13-14 [13] Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers. And the Spirit of the LORD rushed upon David from that day forward. And Samuel rose up and went to Ramah. [14] Now the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and a harmful spirit from the LORD tormented him.
- 4.6. So the Spirit leaves Saul and comes upon **David** at his anointing in 1 Sam 16:13.
 - 4.6.1. Psa 51:11, "Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me." 4.6.2. **Solomon**? (1 Kings 3:7-12).
- 4.7. Jesus.
