Psalm 90

Moses wrote this psalm near the end of a long wilderness journey, contemplating the brevity of human life and the eternality of God. His perspective of man's time on earth is summed up in verse 6. *In the morning it flourishes, and grows up; in the evening it is cut down, and withers.* "HAPPY NEW YEAR," somehow does not appear in that statement.
