

All Our Days

Psalm 90

Moses wrote this psalm near the end of a long wilderness journey, contemplating the brevity of human life and the eternity of God. His perspective of man's time on earth is summed up in verse 6. *In the morning it flourishes, and grows up; in the evening it is cut down, and withers.* "**HAPPY NEW YEAR,**" somehow does not appear in that statement.

I. The **IMMUTABILITY** of God (1-2)

II. The **INFIRMTIY** of man (3-11)

III. The **INTERCESSION** of Moses (12-17)

Anticipation: God's sustaining grace and guidance in the New Year.

Application: ***Teach us to number our days,*** that we may make every day count for eternity.
